

## Do You Qualify for the Cares Act one-time \$350 Benefit?

Households who have been approved for the Energy Assistance Program from October 1, 2020 through May 14, 2021 may be eligible for the one time Cares Act Benefit of \$350. To qualify for the program you must be able to able to answer yes to <u>ALL</u> the question below.

- 1. Your household was approved for EAP from October 1, 2020 through May 14, 2021.
  - If you answered yes, continue to question 2.
  - If no, you will need to submit an application and meet all eligibility requirements for the applicable program year. Application must be received by May 14, 2021.
- 2. A member of your household has experienced job loss or decrease in hours due to the public health crisis caused by the COVID-19 Pandemic.
  - If you answered yes, continue to question 3.
  - If you answered no, you are not eligible for Cares Act one-time \$350 Benefit.
- 3. Are you able to provide supporting documentation of job loss and/or decrease in hours?
  - If you answered yes, <u>Please provide verification of unemployment benefits being received or have employer complete the attached Request for Earnings form.</u>
  - If you answered no, you are not eligible for Cares Act one-time \$350 Benefit.

If you answered yes to all three (3) questions, you qualify for the Cares Act one-time \$350 Benefit.
