# Get Connected with Indy EAP

IndyEAP (Energy Assistance Program) assists with the high costs of home energy. Income-eligible families in Marion County are provided a one-time benefit to offset the high cost of winter utility bills. The program assists with electricity and heating but does not assist with water bills. The energy assistance benefit amount is based on household size, household income, at-risk factors, and fuel source.

Household Size	Last 3 Months Household Income Must NOT EXCEED
1	\$8,059
2	\$10,539
3	\$13,018
4	\$15,498
5	\$17,978
6	\$20,458
7	\$20,923
8	\$21,388

Household income is the gross earned income (and other unearned income) received by all household members aged 18 and above.

### **Important Dates**

- October 1, 2024 | Application available at IndyEAP.org
- December 1, 2024 | Moratorium protection begins. If you have applied for IndyEAP you are protected from disconnection until March 2025.
- March 15, 2025 | Moratorium protection ends
- April 14, 2025 | Last day to submit EAP application
